We will talk about:

- Early signs of labor
- Tips for managing early labor at home
- When to come in to the hospital
- The third stage of labor (the placenta)
- What to pack for your stay in the hospital (for both you and baby)
- Family-centered care at the hospital
- Your green sheet (the clinic birth plan) you signed earlier in pregnancy
- The syphilis blood test after baby is born
- The Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative
- Breastfeeding and infant feeding
